	Morning	Afternoon
Monday	Literacy - The Dragon Machine Can you try building a dragon machine (or a unicorn/ griffin/ creeper machine) using junk modelling. You will need it tomorrow!	History of Toys Can you find out about toys around the world? What do people like to play with in other countries? Is it the same or different? Can you draw or make some of the toys?
	Maths - Count in 2s, 5s and 10s Can you make groups of 2 things - lego is a good resource to use for this, but any small things that can be grouped is good. Do the same for 5s and 10s. Count forwards and backwards.	
Tuesday	Using your model, can you describe how it moves using brilliant wow words? Act out how it moves and write your ideas on labels.	PSHE Make a card for someone who is on their own, or might be missing their friends. Ask your carers to take a picture and send it electronically.
	My Maths Task - counting on and back Go through the online lesson before completing the task.	
Wednesday	Use your labels from Tuesday to write sentences to describe how your machine moves. Can you use full stops, capital letters and beautiful handwriting?	Science Do you have any seeds to grow? Start them indoors now. Think what they will need, and how you can look after them.
	My Maths Task - odds, evens and doubles Go through the online lesson before completing the task.	
Thursday	Your unicorns (griffins etc) are having an amazing adventure. Write a letter from the unicorn (griffin etc) to your main character about what they have been up to. Use your past tense verbs with -ed at the end.	DT Make a piece of parchment paper by gently rubbing a damp, used teabag over a piece of paper. Let it dry ready for tomorrow.
	My Maths Task - number facts and doubles Go through the online lesson before completing the task.	
Friday	Use your parchment and write out your letter from yesterday in your most beautiful handwriting, trying to use careful joined up writing.	RE Jesus rose again and joined God in heaven. What do you think heaven might be like? Use any art or natural materials to create an image.
	Help do some cooking, using careful measurements.
